# WALK WITH WISDOM

## *Today and into the Future*

### **Why Walk with Wisdom?**

Walk with Wisdom is a program to help the Joseph Family explore its charism and mission. It provides a model process for deeper conversations involving charism, world view, stereotypes and conflict while offering a common reflective experience.

### **Who is Walk with Wisdom for?**

The program is designed for sisters, associates and partners in mission, in groups of six to 10, whose members are committed to experiencing the entire program as a small community.

### **What's involved?**

Each of the six sessions invites participants to prayer, video and discussion and reflective activities facilitated by a group member.

### **How long will it take?**

Each session takes two to three hours to complete. Typically, groups complete all six sessions in six to 12 months, depending on the size of the group, the content and frequency of the meetings and the direction of the facilitator.
